Anatomical waste from operating theatres requires special containment and must be stored, transported and disposed of as hazardous waste to ensure that there is no risk to human health or to the environment.

As a licenced waste carrier we have an obligation to our customers to ensure their waste is handled correctly, giving them peace of mind that their anatomical waste has been disposed of correctly.

Instructions for use:

Place anatomical waste in the container such as body parts, organs, blood bags and blood preserves, surgical waste, tissue and solidified embalming fluid. Keep the lid closed when it is not in use.
