

## **BACKGROUND**

The Driver and Vehicle Standards Agency (**DVSA**) is an executive agency of the UK Department for Transport (DfT). It carries out driving tests, approves people to be driving instructors and MOT testers, carries out tests to make sure lorries and buses are safe to drive, carries out roadside checks on drivers and vehicles, and monitors vehicle recalls.

## THE CHALLENGE

**phs** Interclean were called to assist with an urgent clean-up at a DVSA location in Enfield. The area had been broken into and lorry loads of waste and rubbish were illegally dumped on the site. **phs** Interclean were tasked with removing all the waste quickly, efficiently and safely so the area could be fenced and secured. They then had to dispose of the waste in the correct manner, adhering to all duty of care obligations, and clean and disinfect the site.

## **THE SOLUTION**

In order to manage the clean-up of the area, **phs** Interclean supplied the necessary labour and equipment to carry out the work as quickly and efficiently as possible.
