As part of their dedication to constantly improving the well-being of their residents, the care home was looking for a way to reduce the spread of germs and eliminate odours/issues.

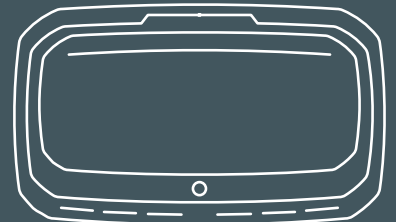


### BACKGROUND

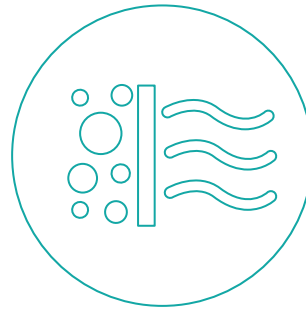
### THE SOLUTION
