

What Apprenticeship have you completed?

I am working towards completing my Electrical Apprenticeship course, to become a qualified Electrician.

Why did you choose to do an Apprenticeship?

When I left school, I had no idea what I wanted to do. I joined a traineeship and took an interest in electrical. I completed my Level 2 and 3 and had a great interest in this area. I applied for lots of jobs and **phs** gave me a job and an opportunity to become qualified.

What have you learnt?

I started off with the basics, learning from the Electrician and taking notes of what they where doing. I have a genuine interest, so I started to do small things like changing light switches, plug sockets. Once my confidence improved, I started to change light fittings. The work is very broad, when I started doing wiring, I started to pick up how things work and how things are run. When you are working alongside someone, they can teach you a lot.

How has it benefited you?

In many ways. Once you are qualified, you are an asset to the company.

Has it helped you overcome any particular challenges?

The challenge for me was to see how far I could go with it. At first it was a goal, but as I began to complete stages of the course, I was wondering how far I could go with it.

Would you enrol onto another Apprenticeship or course?

I am six months away from being qualified, so there is a broad spectrum that I haven't covered yet or done on my own. So, becoming more competent in my field is where my focus is, before completing another Apprenticeship.
