

LifeCycle is our revolutionary solution for the recycling of items such as nappies, incontinence waste and sanitary waste and is unique to **phs**. We process the waste and turn it into Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) to be used in power stations. You can be confident that when you work with us, you are also helping to protect our environment by diverting this waste stream away from landfill.

How our LifeCycle process works



Commercial hygiene waste (i.e. sanitary, incontinence pads and nappies) is collected from cinemas, shopping centres, leisure centres, travel hubs etc and is delivered to our state-of-the-art facility.

Waste is then processed to remove moisture content to leave a raw, clean burnable mass.

CONVERSION The raw material is then burned to create energy. POWER The energy is then used to power factories, schools, public buildings, homes, and even to light washrooms, and the cycle begins again.




